PUBLIC "NATIONAL HEALTH" TREATMENT

Paphos General Hospital

All public health treatment is carried out at Paphos General Hospital (there are no 'national health' GP's). Treatment in A&E is free at the point of service and without formality.

We have had reports that A&E treatment in this hospital is good.

The hospital is located near to the large roundabout at the beginning of the Paphos to Nicosia motorway. Follow the signposts from there. See also [Medical Treatment Orientation Plan](#).
